
# KAFP Journal: Mission

- The Journal has been in its current format (8 1/2x11) since 1990







## Sample of Published Pieces

- Opinion/editorial pieces
- Review articles

## Guidelines for authors

- Recognize that this is a peer reviewed journal, so you may need to make changes based on the evaluation of the reviewers
- The Editor and Associate Editors will decide which articles are appropriate for the journal
- Articles published remain the property of the authors
- A Family Physician should be one of the authors of all journal articles
  - Other specialists are encouraged to collaborate
- Word count should be less than 2500 words for review or study articles
- Word count less than 1500 words for opinion/editorial pieces
- References should be in AMA format (<a href="http://library.nymc.edu/informatics/amastyle.cfm">http://library.nymc.edu/informatics/amastyle.cfm</a>)
- Reference limit of 20

## Guidelines for authors

- Tables, photos, graphs, etc. that are reproduced from other sources will need to permission from the original sources in order to be published in the KAFP Journal.
- Submissions can be sent to any of the editors or associate editors or to Jessica Smith for consideration
